HIGHLIGHTS OF THE FOOD DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM

- **Strong Community Engagement:** The program recorded approximately 2,408 visits in 2025, reflecting participation and trust from the community.
- **Expanded Reach:** We supported 169 households this year, an increase of 64 households (61%) compared to 2024, providing access to nutritious food for more families.
- **Responding to Growing Need:** Food insecurity continues to rise, resulting in more individuals and families seeking support. While this presents a challenge, we are proud to have expanded our reach and continued to provide critical support to the community.
